## Question

This decision addressed pendant luminaires with glass shades needing assembly by the user. The manufacturer wanted to transport the luminaires in parts to protect against breakage. It was noted that there is not always a clear distinction between industrial and domestic luminaires.

## Decision

All Countries agreed that luminaires can only be regarded as a complete unit with all internal wiring in place. However, if needed for industrial luminaires, the luminaire can be supplied in more than one piece". Common sense must be applied having regard to the type of luminaire and the ease of connection.
