Question

1) In our opinion the requirement of § 3.3.7 is not quite clear. Is the phrase "if applicable" referring to general use metal halide lamps which have UV radiation and/or metal halide lamps which can explode? 2) What's your opinion concerning street lighting luminaires with a plastic cover for metal halide lamps with UV radiation?

Shall we require a protective shield as described in Annex P or can we accept a plastic cover which does not stop UV radiation in conjunction with advice on the label "only for lamps without UV radiation"?

Decision

- 1) This protective shield only concerns UV radiation (no mechanical function).
- 2)Luminaire shall comply with Annex P, unless UV blocked lamp is required by marking. Note: marking with minimum mounting height can be used.
