Question			

According to Annex P luminaires intended for use with metal halide lamps shall - if necessary - be fitted with an adequate protection shield in order to avoid UV radiation. Can the protection shield, as mentioned in Annex P, be omitted if:

- a) the manufacturer can prove that the lamp does not emit UV radiation in a deleterious quantity within the area mentioned under P.2 item 3?
- b) Which kind of documentation can one, if necessary, demand?
- c) How or by whom is "ts" and "Ea" (the formula for "T") decided?
- d) Where (distance from the luminaire) is "Ea" to be measured?
- e) Is the clause also valid for luminaires, which can only be used outside (street and open space lighting), where people only spends a short time and where the luminous power normally does not exceed 5-25 lux?

Decision

- a) Yes, we use the information of luminaire and lamp manufacturers.
- b) To be provided by luminaire and lamp manufacturers.
- c) All information from luminaire and lamp manufacturers.
- d) All information from luminaires manufacturer.
- e) In principle yes. To evaluate case by case.
