Question

Is cord anchorage on lampholders used as connectors necessary where the cable may be subjected to strain during lamp replacement (e.g. GU 10 and GZ 10)?

Decision

The following conditions apply:

- class III welded or crimped lampholder contacts are accepted without cord anchorage provided that they are tested according to lampholder standard;
- class III, screw or screwless terminals cord anchorage is required;
- 230 V, class I or class II not acceptable; (cord anchorage, sleeve, protection against contact with live parts, etc.,... is required).
